Soft, fruity and refreshing sparkling wine with citrus, pear and floral flavours and aromas Grape variety: Prosecco.	£7.00	£35

<b>Louis Roederer, Brut, Reims NV</b>		
Combines all the fruitiness and freshness of youth with the vinosity of a fully mature wine. Structured and elegantly mature wine, with a smooth palate and fine bubbles. Grape variety: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier		£110
<b>Bollinger Special Cuvée, Brut</b>		
Its biscuity nose is endowed with hints of white fruit and the rich, full-bodied palate is perfectly balanced by fresh acidity and a soft, delicate mousse. Grape variety: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier		£135
<b>Dom Pérignon, Epernay 2004</b>		
Delicate nose and very ethereal, clean and demure attack. Aromatic and floral and then very sharp and crisp on the palate. The vintage was 'easy' apparently, with no botrytis or other issues and this shows in the pristine lines of this wine. With more Pinot Noir than usual (53%) this offsets the creamy ripe Chardonnay and gives it a more restrictive silhouette. Grape variety: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir		£350
<b>Louis Roederer, Cristal, Reims 2004</b>		
Full bodied and fresh, brimming with candied peach fruit and toasted hazelnuts flavours. A powerful but elegant effervescence with a crisp and complex finish. Grape variety: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir		£380
<b>Armand De Brignac, Brut Gold, Reims</b>		
Marvelously complex and full-bodied, with a bouquet that is fresh and lively. Its sumptuous, racy fruit character is perfectly integrated with the wine's subtle brioche accents. Its texture is creamy and the palate has great depth and impact with a long and silky finish.		£500

### Pierre Paillard Grand Cru Rosé NV

Crystalline and pale pink colours. The sparkle is tiny and elegant. The first nose is mineral and flowery followed by aromas of small red fruit (raspberry, redcurrant) and freshly pressed citrus (grapefruit, mandarin orange). The Chardonnay brings minerality and freshness, blended with more intense notes of wild strawberries. Grape variety: 70% Chardonnay and 30% Pinot Noir

### Taittinger Rosé, Reims NV

Intense cherry-pink colour with extremely fine bubbles rising in delicate strands to the surface of the wine. Classic, aromatic Pinot fragrance of red raspberries and strawberries is offset by elegant, subtle floral and earth nuances. On the palate, the ripe, full berry flavours are vibrant yet refined, delicately balanced by a fresh acidity which carries into a crisp, refreshing finish of persistent length. Grape variety: Chardonnay 30%, Pinot Noir 45%, Pinot Meunier 25%

### Laurent-Perrier Rosé NV

Held in an elegant bottle inspired by King Henri IV. It has a highly expressive bouquet, stemming from very careful preservation of fresh fruit aromas during the wine making. Intensely fruity flavours, clean and slightly sharp, the wine opens to the sensation of freshly picked red berries: strawberries, Morello cherries, black currants and raspberries.

Grape variety: Made with 100% Pinot Noir from 10 different "crus" (or villages), from the North and South areas of the Montagne de Reims, as well as the famous

The palate almost shimmers with tang and vibrancy, and although it has a steely precision, it is balanced by fruit with a peachy pear-like quality and backed by a vivid streak of lemon and mineral acidity

### **Dinastia Vivanco Crianza, Rioja, Spain 2010**

Oak barrel notes of cinnamon show up in the nose of this wine; coffee notes that derive from heavily toasted barrels are lurking too. But everything is in balance, even if the wine is still evolving, as black and red cherries and currants marry up with those toast notes. The tannins are relatively soft throughout, and there is a gentle lingering blueberry, barrel-tinged finish.

### **Catena Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 2012**

Ripe, concentrated dark fruit aromas with delicate floral notes and traces of vanilla and mocha. Rich and lush on the palate, with concentrated black cherry and red currant fruit flavours layered with sweet spices, tobacco and a touch of leather. The finish presents soft, supple tannins with bright, crisp acidity and a flinty minerality which gives the wine exceptional length.

Very good balance and complexity to this sweet Hungarian wine. Deep, roasted fruit notes are complemented by lively, fresh apricot and quince. Luscious yet sprightly, with a beautiful blossomy scent and a fresh finish. Glazed peach and honey overflow from the nose, counterbalanced by lovely earthy nuances.

### **Monbazillac, L'ancienne Cure, South West France, 2011 37.5cl**

An excellent dessert wine, very sweet and fresh with balanced acidity. Golden yellow and concentrated in colour. On the nose aromas of honey, peaches and acacia. Unctuous and full-textured on the palate with notes of crystallised fruits and apricots. The classic accompaniment to foie gras and also great with blue cheese or tarte tatin. .

Gold colour concentrated aromas of tropical fruits and honey. On the palate, this wine is delicate and elegant.
